Federal financial aid options offered

HCC has received \$59 million in federal Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds for use in helping students who have been adversely affected by the pandemic and current economic crisis. Funds are available on a first-come, first-served basis, and will be distributed until all funding has been allocated. Additional technology support is available

HCC is also supporting students in their educational journey with several options for obtaining computers and internet access. Discounts are available on the purchase of computers from leading manufacturers. The college also offers free use of software from leading companies such as Microsoft and Adobe.
