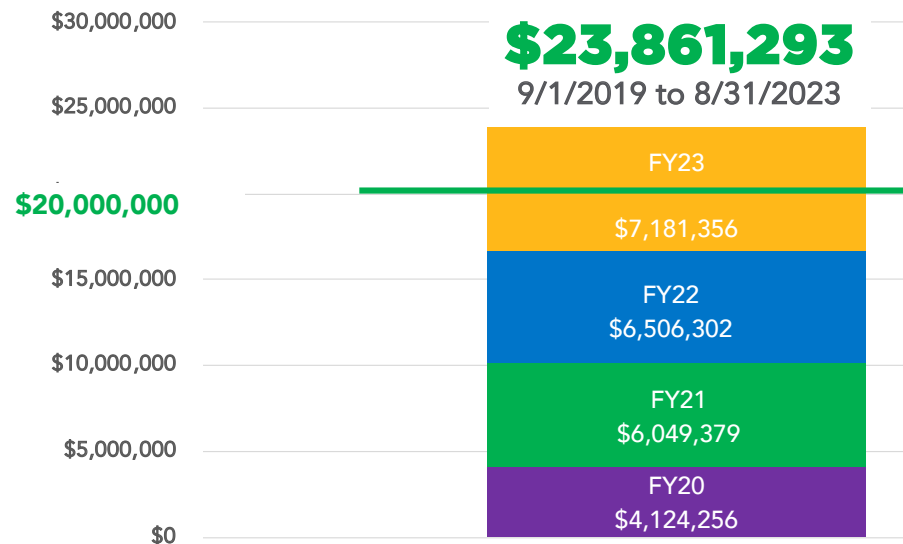

HCC's Invest in Houston's Future Campaign was launched on September 1, 2019, with a \$20 million goal, and scheduled to end on August 31, 2024. When we started, we didn't know how we were going to achieve this goal. We saw hearts and hands rise to the challenge and we topped our \$20 million campaign goal achieving **\$23,861,293** in FY23, 16 months ahead of schedule. We would like to honor our important partnership with HCC's leadership in the campaign. Leading this charge was HCC Chancellor (former) **Dr. Cesar Maldonado** and his unwavering commitment to student success combined with his personal philanthropic support. In addition, we are grateful for the support of **Izzy Anderson, Terry Corrigan, and Ashley Smith**. We appreciate each of you.

leads an award-winning Entrepreneurial Program. The Goldman Sachs 10,000 Small Businesses Program is in its 11th year at HCC and has trained over 1,000 entrepreneurs at HCC and is funded by a \$1 million annual grant.

Over and above the Goldman Sachs more than \$4 million received during the campaign, the Entrepreneurial Program received \$900,000 in program support from Wells Fargo for the Women of Color Success Series; Mattress Mack School of Selling; Business Plan Competition; and an endowed contribution from Entrepreneur in Residence David Regenbaum with Naming Recognition for **the Glenda and David Regenbaum Center for Entrepreneurship at HCC Northwest**. The private funding grant support totals over \$6.2 million.



Vice Chancellor, Workforce and Southwest College President Dr. Madeline Burillo-Hopkins is a

visionary, and she engages industry partners to invest in Houston's future, HCC Students, through academic programs. as President of Southwest College and Vice Chancellor for Workforce Programs. She stewards relationships with existing partners such as PVF Roundtable and EHCMA. Under her leadership, the doors of new partnerships have been opened with technology giants such as Apple, Intel, and NVIDIA. Consumer products giants such as PepsiCo are investing in supply chain jobs through an innovative scholarship program. She has gotten HCC's apprenticeship program off the ground, meeting the critical need for our students to work and go to school at the same time and getting much-needed skills in the workforce. Dr. Burillo-Hopkins personally contributes each year to the Faculty and Staff campaign with lead gifts. Her philanthropic leadership during the HCC's Invest in Houston's Future Campaign tops \$4 million.

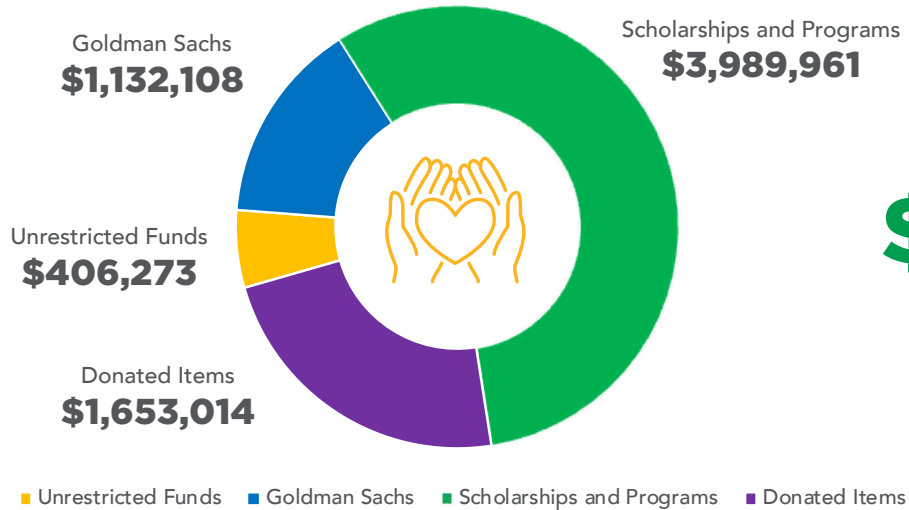

HCCF Financial Results FY17 to FY23

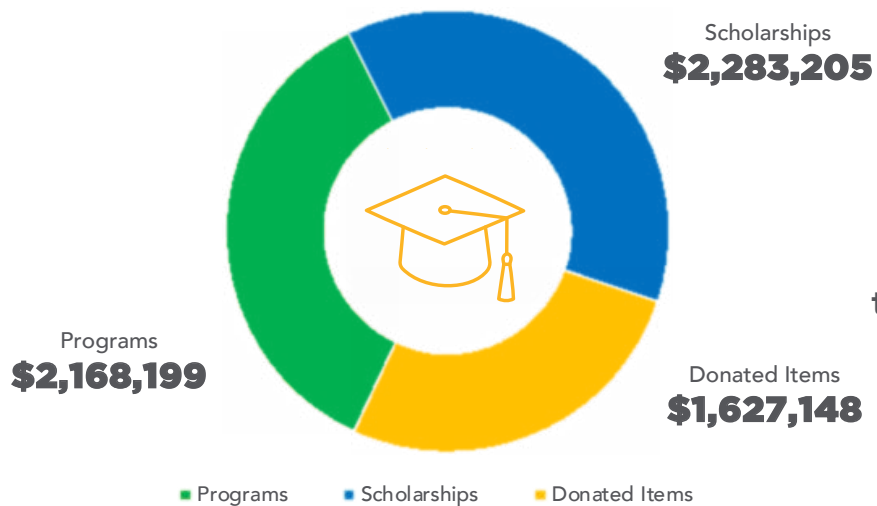


FY 2023 TOTAL CONTRIBUTIONS & FUNDS PROVIDED TO HCC
